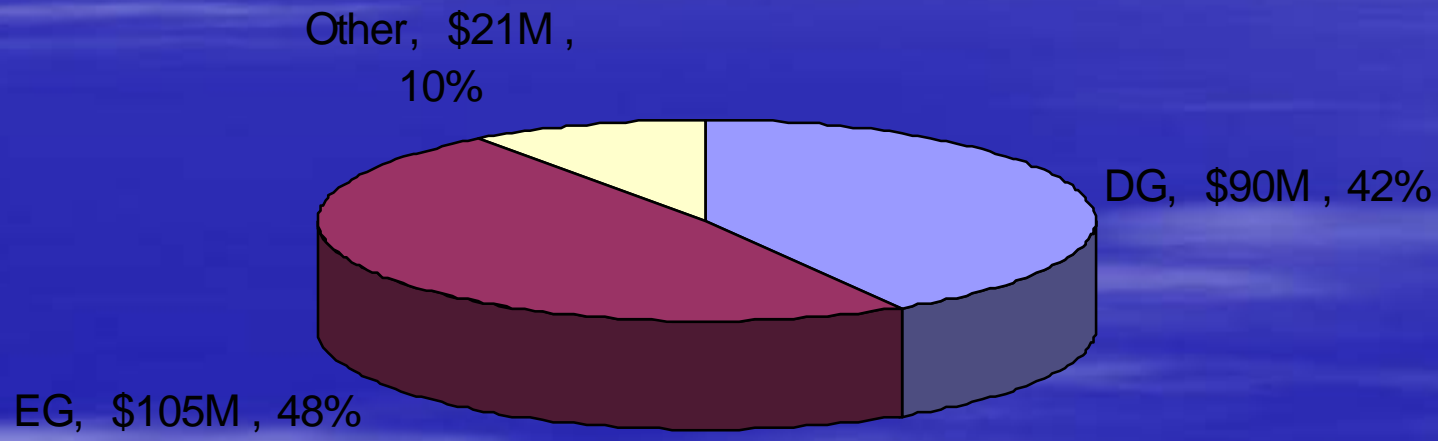

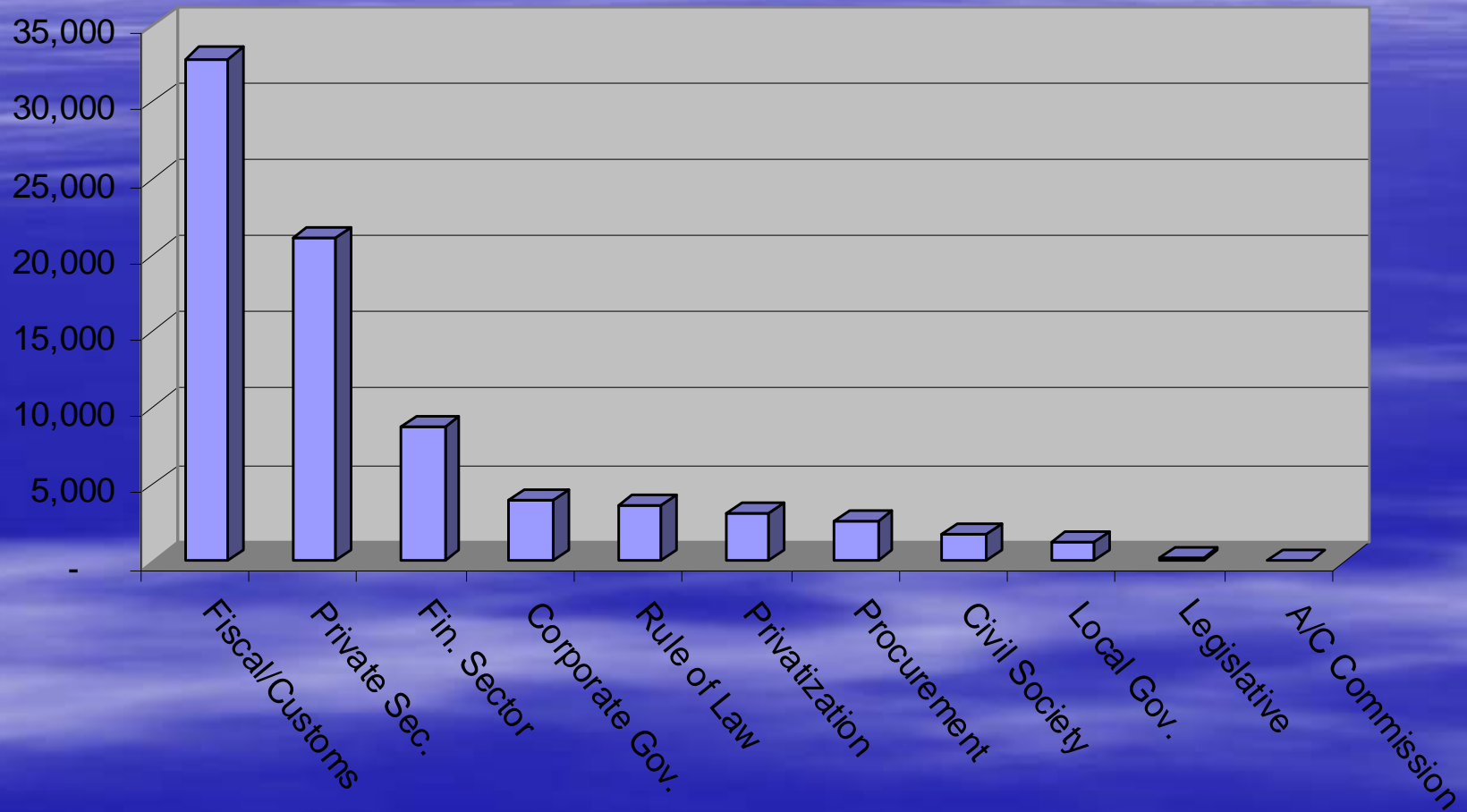

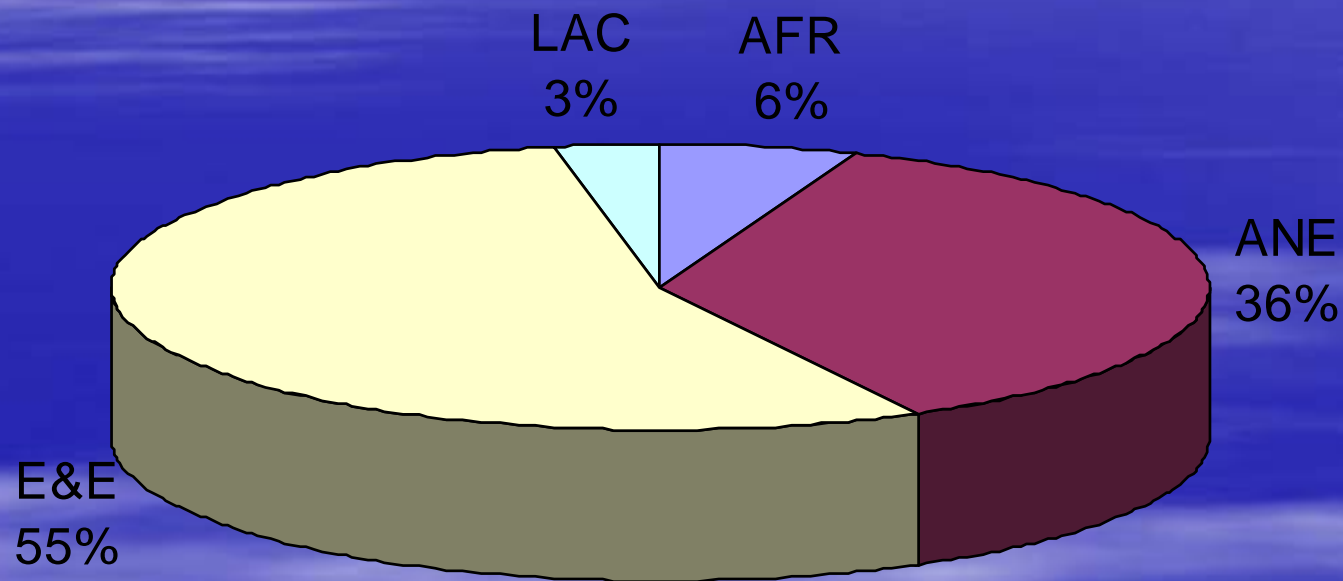
Anti-Corruption Programs by Sector (FY02) (\$215M)



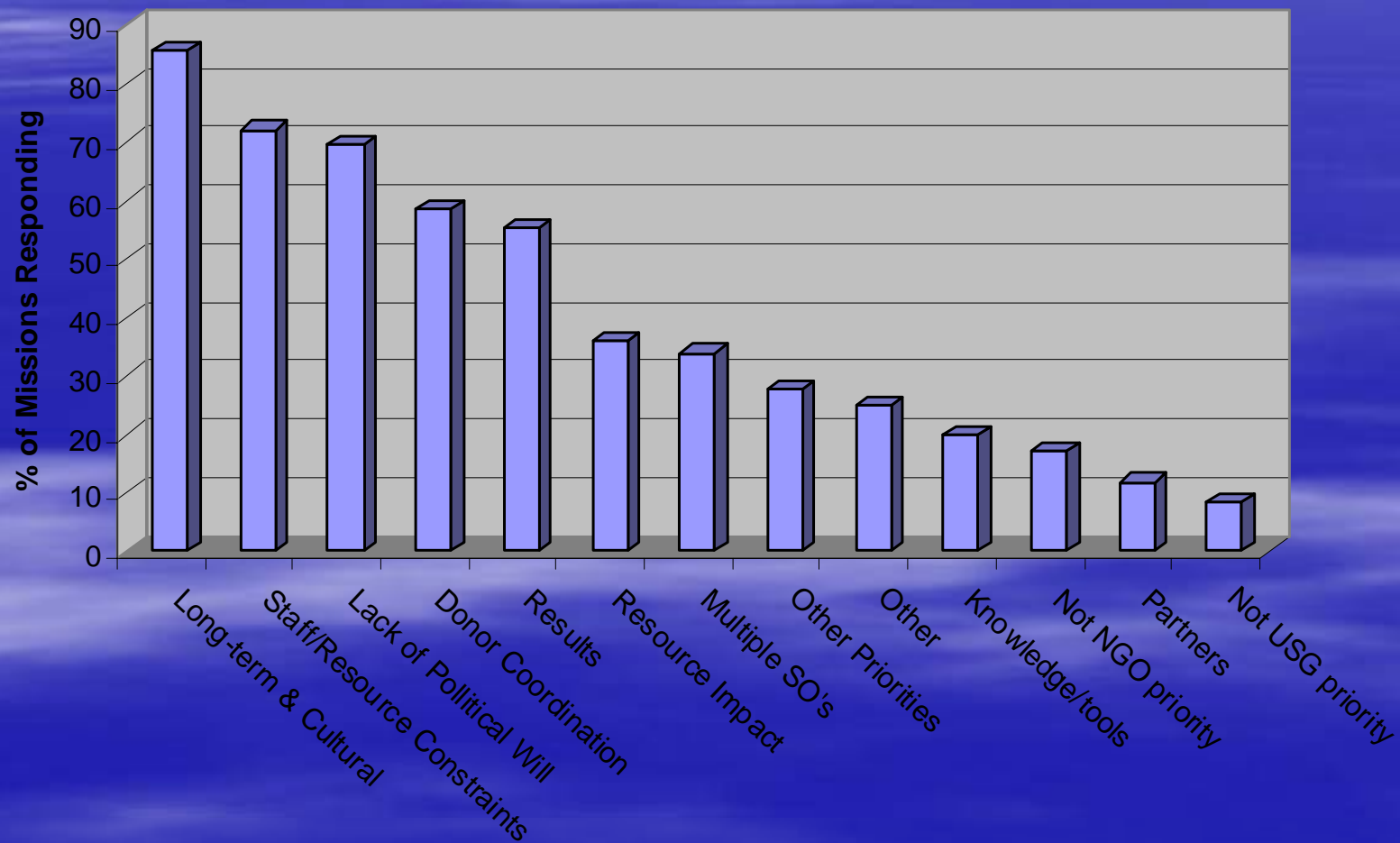
EG A/C Programs ('000s) FY02

Effective Approaches

- Not one single program; confluence of factors.
- Key factors, according to Missions—
 - Political will
 - Programs generating demand for reform
 - Assistance to strengthen government institutions
 - Local ownership of efforts
- Multi-pronged Approaches

Ineffective Approaches

- Absence of Political Will as Main Factor
 - Examples:
 - Public awareness programs not tied to reforms.
 - Reforms without public awareness programs.
 - Institutional reforms absent political will.
 - Failure to take long-term approach.
 - ACCs without mandate, resources.
- More...

Ineffective Approaches

- Examples:
 - Recommendations unsupported by research and data collection.
 - Roundtables and policy dialogue efforts when the key issues are well understood.
 - Donor driven programs that are perceived as such.
